Our Principles


Unitarian Universalist congregations affirm and promote:

Facilities Available for Use

Our sanctuary was designed by Gossens Bachman Architects to reflect our commitment to environmental responsibility by minimizing our carbon footprint. It has an excellent audio system and outstanding acoustics, as well as a grand piano. We find that artificial lighting is optional during the daylight hours.

The Fenn House is our second building, renovated to include meeting and classroom space as well as a full kitchen and a small chapel with an upright piano.

Our buildings and restrooms are accessible to wheelchairs, with the exception of the Fenn House Chapel and the Basement Classroom and Game Room.

Sanctuary Building

Sanctuary

This space will seat 260 people. The fee for a wedding (up to three hours) is \$300; for concerts and other events it is \$250. Each additional hour is \$100. Additional fees cover use of the piano, audio system, kitchenette, nursery, and Gatekeeper/supervisor (required).



Meeting Room

This space seats 10-12 people around a table. The fee for three hours of use is \$50, and includes WiFi, telephone, and data jacks.

Fenn House

The entire house is available for up to three hours for a fee \$100. Individual spaces can be used as follows (again, the rates are for three hours):

Chapel

This space can accommodate about 30 people. Tables and chairs are available. There is an outside entrance, a stage, a counter with a sink, and an upright piano. \$50.

Kitchen and Dining Area

This is a full kitchen with a table that seats 8. \$50.

Fenn House Meeting Rooms

The Spring Room seats 8-12 and is available for \$25. The Blue Room seats 6-8 for a fee of \$20. Each has a counter with sink.

Basement Classroom & Game Room

Available for \$20, this space is particularly suitable for youth activities.

Smoking and alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the premises.
