

Interfaith Summer Potluck Picnic @ Kingsland Bay State Park, Sat. July 22 gathering at 11 am & eating at 12 pm. Middlebury Friends Meeting (Quakers) are hosting a picnic to which CVUUS and Havurah (Jewish congregation) is also invited. Our three faith groups had a long tradition of gathering for a potluck picnic at Button Bay so this is a resurrection of that. Admittance to

park is \$4 or free for seniors with Green Mountain State Park pass (age 62+) which you can get at your town clerk's office. Some games will be provided and encouraged, but bring yours, as well as your own plates and utensils and chairs and kayak.

Migrant Worker Support: Remember that Addison Allies Network (AAN) is looking for volunteers to provide rides to migrant workers and their families for medical and dental appointments and to escort workers who need driving practice to qualify for their licenses (no teaching required). AAN sends out emails to a list of potential drivers with the date, time, and location of the ride requested. If you can provide the ride, you respond to the request and AAN provides further details. If you can't just hit delete. Masks are commonly worn by drivers and passengers. Our area migrant workers are glad to call us home and will be back for the next Mexican Consulate visit on Oct 28 and welcome us to help with their Fiesta on July 30, 3-8 pm in the Marbleworks. Let Lise Anderson know if you would like to join the list of potential drivers or help with the Fiesta.
